Clinica Pastor Now With TWELVE Accu SPINA



The Demise of Traction & The Rise of IDD Therapy Spinal Decompression

During the twentieth century, almost all physiotherapy clinics had some sort of 'traction' device which would be used to treat back pain and sometimes neck pain.

These generally crude devices consisted of a winching motor fitted to the end of a treatment couch.

Patients would be connected to the motor with a pulley and a rope, tugging the lower back to try to unload it.





traditional mechanical traction had severe limitations and gave inconsistent results. Thus traction as a modality went out of favour and use.

The failure of traditional traction - and even ordinary decompression devices - lay in the inability to treat specific spinal levels and in the aggressive, jolt-type pulling that could create spasm and increased pain.

IDD Therapy spinal decompression with oscillation was developed to address traditional traction's failings.



Using computer software-directed vectors, distraction forces were applied at measured angles to target spinal segments, with optimal force and advanced dynamic patterns that bring about change. With a patented oscillation technique to provide mobilisation, IDD Therapy enabled clinicians to do more for patients with a goal to avoid pain medication and invasive treatments.

Traction is in the DNA of IDD Therapy, but IDD Therapy leaped along the evolutionary path to create a whole new category of conservative (non-invasive) spine care fit for the twenty first century.
