Is It Time To Rethink Sciatica Injections?

In the arena of sciatic pain management, steroid injections are commonly used in an attempt to provide temporary pain relief to patients. The aim being to numb pain, reduce inflammation and nerve swelling, and allow patients to engage in treatments which address the underlying causes of sciatica.

However, spinal injections are rarely if ever given in conjunction with a definitive rehab programme. In the UK, the average cost of spinal steroid injections is over £1,000. Since research suggests that steroid injections fall short of providing lasting relief, wouldn't it be more cost-effective to combine or focus on treatment and rehabilitation from the very start?



Steroid injections do not address the underlying causes of sciatica

Among IDD Therapy providers, a question commonly asked is how soon a patient can begin treatment after an injection. Two weeks are recommended to allow the injection to settle.
